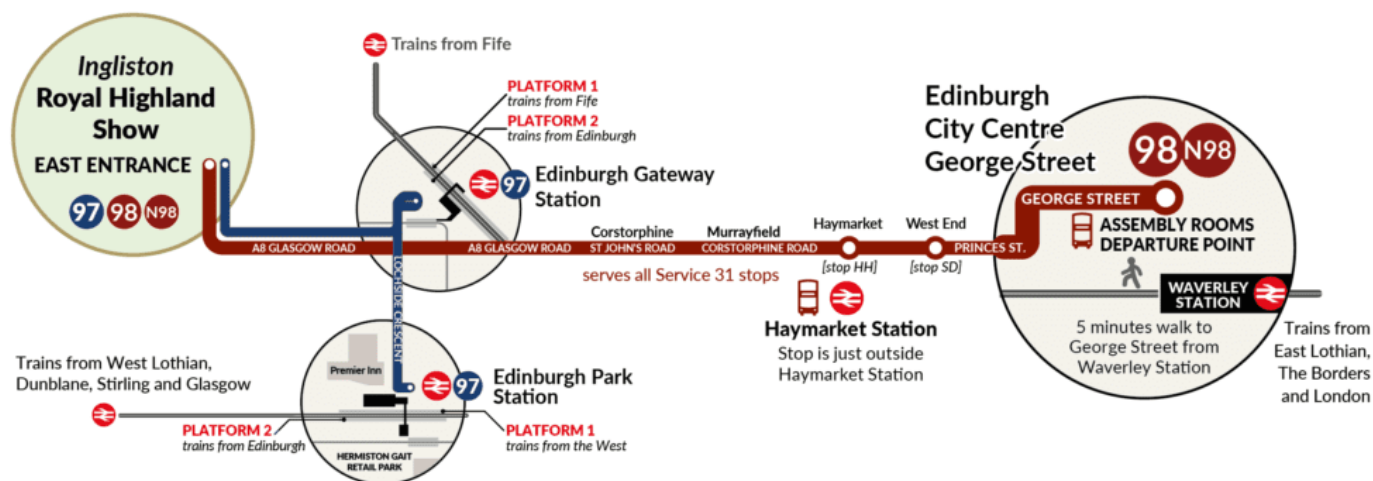
## From EDINBURGH CITY CENTRE and HAYMARKET

### Service 98: Edinburgh City Centre (George Street) – Haymarket Station – Royal Highland Show



With frequent departures from George Street, a short walk from Waverley Station, and buses stopping at key locations such as Shandwick Place, Haymarket Station, Murrayfield, Edinburgh Zoo and Corstorphine, Lothian Service 98 is the most convenient way to get to the Royal Highland Show. During busy periods, buses are departing up to every 5 minutes and will get you from Edinburgh City Centre right to the Royal Highland Show in approximately 30 minutes.

#### Where to find Service 98 in Edinburgh City Centre?



Service 98 departs from George Street (Assembly Rooms), then stops at Shandwick Place (stop SD), Haymarket (stop HH) then all stops along the A8 to Maybury.

#### Thursday 19 June

**Departures from George Street (Assembly Rooms):** 0625, 0645, 0700, 0715, 0730, 0740, 0750 then frequent departures until 2125.

**Departures from Royal Highland Centre, East Gate:** 0705, 0725, 0740, 0755, 0810 then frequent departures until 2220.

## Friday 20 June

**Departures from George Street (Assembly Rooms):** 0625, 0645, 0700, 0715, 0730, 0740, 0750 then frequent departures until 2125.

**Departures from Royal Highland Centre, East Gate:** 0705, 0725, 0740, 0755, 0810 then frequent departures until 2202.

**Departures from Royal Highland Centre, West Gate (for the Royal Highland Hoolie):** frequent departures between 2230 and 2250.

## Saturday 21 June

**Departures from George Street (Assembly Rooms):** 0625, 0645, 0700, 0715, 0730, 0740, 0750 then frequent departures until 2125.

**Departures from Royal Highland Centre, East Gate:** 0700, 0720, 0735, 0750, 0805 then frequent departures until 2220.

**Departures from Royal Highland Centre, West Gate (for the Royal Highland Hoolie):** frequent departures between 2230 and 2250.

## Sunday 22 June

**Departures from George Street (Assembly Rooms):** 0630, 0700, 0720, 0740, 0755, 0810, 0820 then frequent departures until 1830.





**Departures from Royal Highland Centre, East Gate:** 0705, 0735, 0755, 0815, 830, 0845, 0855 then frequent departures until 1900, 1915.

## From EDINBURGH PARK and EDINBURGH GATEWAY STATIONS

### Service 97: Edinburgh Park Station – Edinburgh Gateway Station – Royal Highland Show



This service provides a convenient connection to Show attendees travelling by train from Glasgow and the West of Scotland at Edinburgh Park Station, and from Fife, Dundee and the Highlands at Edinburgh Gateway Station. Buses operate frequently and drop you off right outside the Royal Highland Centre at the East Gate.

## From NORTH EDINBURGH

---

### Lothian Service 17

Lothian Service 17 operates from Ocean Terminal to Edinburgh Airport via Newhaven, Granton, Muirhouse, Blackhall, Clermiston and DrumBrae. Alight at Airport Hotels and follow Yellow walking route to East Entrance.

Buses up to every 30 minutes.

## From SOUTH EDINBURGH

---

### Lothian Service 18

Lothian Service 18 operates from Fort Kinnaird to Edinburgh Airport via Royal Infirmary, Kaimes, Mortonhall, Oxfangs, Westside Plaza and Sighthill. Alight at Airport Hotels and follow Yellow walking route to East Entrance.

## From GLASGOW

---

### Citylink 900/AIR

Citylink 900 service from Buchanan Station to A8 (Ingliston Road), outside South Entrance

Citylink AIR service from Buchanan Bus Station to Airport Hotels, then follow Yellow walking route to East Entrance

Journey time: 1h10mn (inc. 10mn walk). Buses up to every 15 minutes.

### Train

Scotrail service from Glasgow Queen Street Station to Edinburgh Park Station, then check travel information from Edinburgh Park Station.

Journey time: 1h20mn

## From WEST LOTHIAN

---

### Lothiancountry X18 – Whitburn, Armadale, Bathgate, Uphall, Broxburn

Lothiancountry Service X18 operates direct from **Whitburn, Armadale, Bathgate, Uphall, Broxburn** to A8 (Ingliston Road) with buses up to every 30 minutes.

### Lothiancountry X19 - Winchburgh

Lothiancountry Service X19 operates direct from **Winchburgh** to A8 (Ingliston Road) with buses up to every 30 minutes.

### Citylink 902 - Livingston

Citylink Service 902 from **Livingston Centre** to Airport Hotels, then follow Yellow walking route to East Entrance

Journey time: 35mn (inc. 7mn walk). Buses up to every hour.

### Midland Bluebird X38 – Linlithgow, Winchburgh

Midland Bluebird Service X38 from Linlithgow to A8 (Ingliston Road).

Journey time: 35mn. Buses up to every 30 minutes.

### Train

Scotrail service from Railway Stations in West Lothian to either Edinburgh Park Station or Haymarket Station, then check travel information from Edinburgh Park Station or Haymarket Station

Journey time: depending on origin

## From FALKIRK

---

### Midland Bluebird X38

Midland Bluebird Service X38 from Falkirk Centre to A8 (Ingliston Road).

Journey time: 55mn. Buses up to every 30 minutes.

### Train

Scotrail service from Falkirk Grahamston to Edinburgh Park Station, then check travel information from Edinburgh Park Station.

Journey time: 50mn

## From STIRLING

---

### Citylink 909

Citylink Service 909 from Stirling Bus Station to A8 (Ingliston Road).

Journey time: 55mn. Buses up to every 2 hours.

### Train

Scotrail service from Stirling Station to Edinburgh Park Station, then check travel information from Edinburgh Park Station.

Journey time: 1h05mn

## From FIFE

---

### Stagecoach 747

Stagecoach Service 747 from Halbeath or Ferrytoll P&R to A8 (Ingliston Road).

Journey time: 30 to 40mn. Buses up to every 30 minutes.

### Scotrail

Various stations in Fife to Edinburgh Gateway Station

then check travel information from Edinburgh Gateway Station

Journey time: depending on origin

## From other places in the Country

---

### Long Distance Coaches

Citylink, Megabus, Ember and Flixbus operate regular services from across the UK to **Edinburgh Coach Station** in the City Centre. From there check travel information from Edinburgh City Centre: Service 98 or Edinburgh Trams.

Some Ember and Flixbus services also call at Ingliston Park&Ride. A shuttle bus is available from Ingliston Park&Ride or walk the Green walking route to South Entrance.
